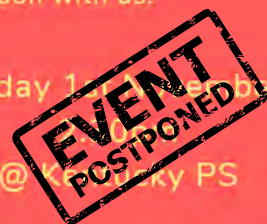

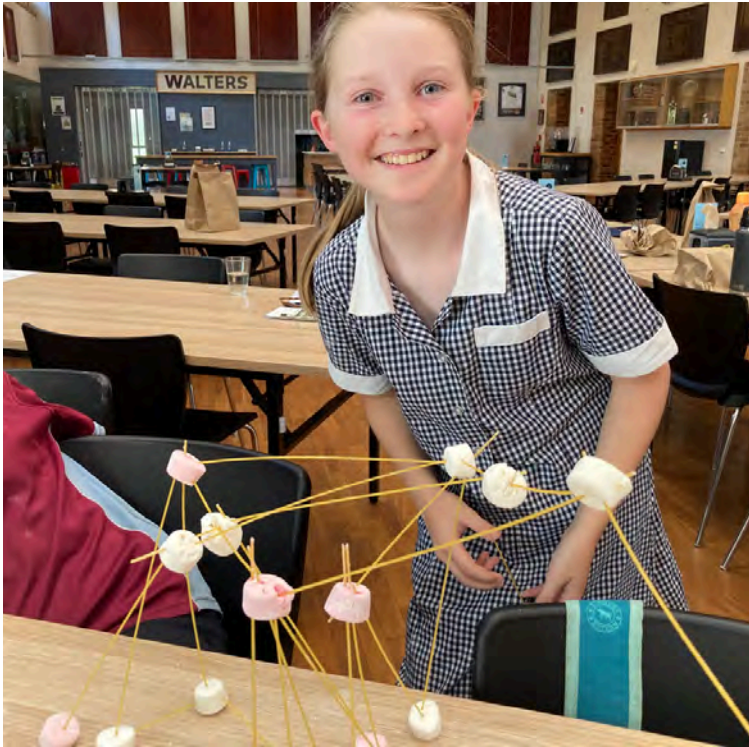

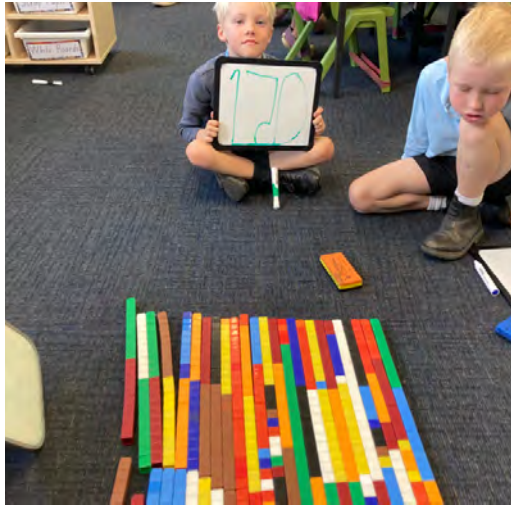
“New England Sings was very fun. The kids got to learn how to preform and were able gain musical skills. The conductors were very nice and made it all extremely fun.”
